### ACADEMIC CALENDAR

*August 1st:* Financial aid registration deadline. Last day for returning students to register full-time in order to ensure fellowship payment during the first week of classes.

*August 26th:* Last day to apply for leave of absence for Fall 2019. Last day to drop for 100% tuition refund. Last day to file ePermit request.

*August 27th:* First day of classes for Fall 2019 semester. All student who register on or after this day must pay tuition and fees in full at that time, including \$25 late registration fee. Students making adjustment to an already existing enrollment on or after this day will be assessed an \$18 Program Adjustment Fee.

*September 2nd:* Last day to register for Fall 2019 semester. Last day to drop for 75% tuition refund. Labor Day observed. The Graduate Center is closed.

*September 5th:* Classes follow Monday schedule.

*September 9th:* Last day to drop for 50% tuition refund.
